This is also an "in-studio dress rehearsal." Students' come dressed in complete recital costume including tights and accessories. Siblings may be photographed together. NO ORDER FORM, NO PICTURE.

### Yearbook/Recital Program Picture

To ensure that your child's picture is in the yearbook, the following is required by April 12<sup>th</sup>.

- Picture taken at studio during picture week: April 6-12
- Purchase of a picture package
- Yearbook space ordered with studio and purchased by April 12<sup>th</sup>.

### **Questions & Answers**

What is the difference between Yearbook space & Business ads?

Yearbook space: showcases a picture of your child/children in a beautiful memory keepsake.

Business ads: Is an opportunity to have your local businesses viewed by over 4,000 people.

**Do I have to buy recital photos to get Yearbook space?** Yes, only photos taken at the studio during picture week, with the purchase of a picture package, are eligible for the yearbook.

Can I put a picture of my child in a Business ad? Yes, with the purchase of a picture package.

When is Yearbook space & Business ads due? On or before April 12th. NO EXCEPTIONS.

How do I get a Recital Yearbook? This is our program and handed out free at the recitals.
